<b>Report</b>	The main idea of the project – to consider family rites as the part of intangible cultural heritage of the Kazakhs the conservation of which is stipulated by the State program «Look into the future: the modernization of public consciousness» as the first condition for modernization of a new type. Family rites meets all the criteria for determining it as an intangible cultural heritage: it is passed down from generation to generation; forms a sense of identity; contributes to the sustainable development of society.
<b>Purpose</b>	To describe the current state of the family rites of the Kazakhs in Western Kazakhstan (Aktobe, Mangistau, Atyrau, West Kazakhstan regions) as a result of historical development in a complex synthesis of its traditional basis and modernized components.
<b>Expected results</b>	<p>The collected and analyzed materials on the family rites of the Kazakhs of Western Kazakhstan will be put into wide scientific circulation, used to write lecture courses on ethnography, seminar programs, and may form the basis of the museum's interactive programs.</p> <p>Based on the collected documents and materials, the manuscript of the monograph “The role of family rites in the context of intangible heritage theory (on the example of West Kazakhstan)” an article will be published in a foreign peer-reviewed journal indexed by international databases, either Web of Science or Scopus, articles in journals recommended by CCES MES RK.</p>
