<b>Report</b>	The project is devoted to investigate ethnical stereotypes and laughter category in humor discourse in terms of comparison (Kazakh, Russian, Arabian, English, French). The following issues will be solved on the topic of project, which were not considered in previous studies: the cognitive and discursive theory of humor discourse will be studied consistently and systematically, characteristic features of humor discourse will be identified, their significance in determining the national code will be shown; cogniotypic characteristics and pragmatic conditions for the formation of small forms humor texts will be determined; the construction of language tools that determine the national world picture in humorous texts will be described based on the materials of different languages; universal features and national features in the humor discourse of each cultural community that are subject to study will be identified, analyzed, concluded; an ethnopsychological portrait of Kazakh, Russian, Arabian, English, French people will be created as a result of the study.
<b>Relevance</b>	The scientific novelty of the project is defined by the comparative aspect of ethnical stereotypes and laughter category in humor discourse for the first time and the creation of an ethnopsychological portrait of each nation (on the basis of Kazakh, Russian, Arabic, English, French materials). The first study of genre specificity of humor discourse in the framework of Linguoculturology, Discourse Theory, Text Linguistics is the scientific novelty of this project. The concepts of “humor discourse”, “ethnonym”, “ethnic stereotype” are studied and defined through previous studies, and the features inherent in humor discourse genre are clarified.
<b>Purpose</b>	The aim of the project is to determine the national peculiarities of humor discourse on the basis of Kazakh, Russian, Arabian, English, French humorous stories; to identify each nation’s features and universal characteristics of national worldview and mentality by comparison analysis of ethnical stereotypes and laughter category in humor discourse.
