4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the Council in the year under review, highlighting the following sections:

1) Analysis of the topics of the reviewed works:

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov A. Utegenova was carried out on the topic "Linguistic and ethnolinguistic situation in the western region of the Republic of Kazakhstan". The study was conducted in collaboration with Biray Nergiz, PhD, a foreign scientific consultant from Pamukkale University (Denizli, Turkey).

The purpose of the study is to describe the current linguistic and ethnolinguistic situation in the western region of the Republic of Kazakhstan, identify its features, and develop scientific and practical recommendations to ensure linguistic and ethnolinguistic balance.

The practical significance of the research is determined by the possibility of using its results in teaching the disciplines "Introduction to Linguistics", "General Linguistics", "Sociolinguistics", and "Psycholinguistics". Scientific and practical recommendations can serve as a basis for the implementation of language policy in Kazakhstan. Collected audio materials of spontaneous oral speech by students from the western region of Kazakhstan in Kazakh, Russian, and English (496 fragments with a total duration of 125 minutes) can replenish the oral subcorpus of the National Corpus and become a base for further research.

4. Brief analysis of dissertations reviewed by the council in the reporting year, highlighting the following sections:

1) Analysis of the topics of the works reviewed:

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of the Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov P.S. Sydyk is written on the topic "Language reflection: discursive analysis (based on literary texts in Kazakh and English). The study was conducted in collaboration with a foreign scientific consultant - candidate of philological sciences, associate professor Sadyralieva Gulshan Erkinturovna from the Bishkek State University named after K. Karasayev (Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan).

The study aims to identify, compare, and describe the methods of verbalizing reflection in Kazakh and English (in the text) and Kazakh and English words (in discourse) through discursive analysis of linguistic reflection expressed in literary texts in Kazakh and English.

The practical significance of the research is determined by the possibility of using its results to conduct courses in general linguistics, discourse theory, reflexive linguistics, and theory of linguistics. An example of the use of the "Cyclic Reflection Model" by G. Gibbs, a sample of the use of metatext comment analysis schemes, and experience in determining linguistic reflection can serve as a model basis for carrying out work in this area. The "Model of reflexive text analysis", presented to form and develop linguistic reflection of students in the educational program "Kazakh Language and Literature" and "Philology", will be useful to future professional linguists.

4. Brief analysis of dissertations reviewed by the council in the reporting year, highlighting the following sections:

1) Analysis of the topics of the works reviewed:

The dissertation work of Tukhtarova Akmaral Serdaliyevna, a doctoral student at Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov, was conducted on the topic "Linguistic and cultural aspects of audiovisual texts in Kazakh, English and Russian".

Joint research was conducted with a foreign scientific consultant Dilara Akhmetovna Ichkineeva, Candidate of Philology, Associate Professor at Ufa University of Science and Technology (Ufa, Bashkortostan, Russia).

The purpose of the study is to identify common and distinctive national and cultural features of audiovisual texts and their adaptation in Kazakh, English, and Russian.

The practical significance of the dissertation research is that its results and the collected practical material will be used in teaching courses in Kazakh, English, and Russian languages, when writing student scientific papers, Master's theses, in the professional activities of translation agencies, as well as in the development of training courses in linguoculturology, cognitive linguistics, linguoconceptology, discourse study, stylistics, etc. analysis of texts for students of educational programs of higher education in the areas of Kazakh (Russian) language and literature, philology (Kazakh, foreign, Russian), foreign language and translation.

In total, the doctoral student has published 8 scientific papers, including 3 articles published in publications recommended by the Committee for Quality Assurance in Science and Higher Education of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, 2 articles published in the *International Journal of Society, Culture and Language* (86% percentile, Q1, 2021), indexed in the Scopus database, and 3 articles are presented in the proceedings of international conferences.

The reviewers, Doctor of Philology, Professor A. Islam and Doctor of Philology, Professor L. Samsitova, showed a high level of professionalism. The reviewers have given some suggestions and comments on Tukhtarova's dissertation work.:

- 1) Attention should be paid to a thorough definition of the theoretical basis of the study, identifying the key concepts and prerequisites underlying linguoculturology.;
- 2) It is important to provide an in-depth analysis of the methodology used to study audiovisual texts, including justification for the choice of specific research tools;
- 3) An equally important aspect is the comprehensive analysis of the collected data, which should include the comparison and interpretation of the results in the context of cross-linguistic and intercultural interactions.;
- 4) We consider the hypothesis in the introduction of the dissertation to be superfluous since the experiment was conducted only on one of the aspects of the study.;
- 5) In the dissertation, when considering linguistic and cultural adaptation, the target audience is not sufficiently highlighted.

These remarks do not detract from the achieved research results and are recommendatory.

4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the Council during the reporting year, highlighting the following sections:

1) analysis of the subject of the considered works;

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of the ARU named after K. Zhubanov Baltymova M.R. was carried out on the topic "Kazakh children's folklore: genesis, typology, poetics".

Joint research was conducted with a foreign scientific consultant Azap Samet PhD, associate professor of the Belarusian State University, Minsk, Republic of Belarus (Minsk, Republic of Belarus).

The purpose of the work is to consider the formation and development of the Kazakh children's folklore study, to determine its classification and genre features, artistic character, and plot-compositional structure.

The practical significance of the scientific work is the scientific concepts and conclusions obtained during the research can be successfully applied in the development and educational support of educational courses and programs in folklore studies, children's folklore, general folklore, and Kazakh children's folklore. The research materials will be valuable for compiling literary reference books, dictionaries on children's folklore, etc.

4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the Council during the reporting year, highlighting the following sections:

1) analysis of the subject of the considered works;

The dissertation work of G.S.Obayeva, a doctoral student at Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov, was carried out on the topic "Folklore motifs in the works of art by G. Musrepov".

The dissertation work was carried out in collaboration with a foreign scientific consultant, Professor Soylemez Orhan, PhD, University of Kastamonu (Kastamonu, Turkey).

The purpose of the study is to analyze the features of the use of folklore motifs in the works of G. Musrepov.

The practical value of the work: The results of the dissertation research and the collected practical materials can be used in educational courses on literary studies and folklore studies, in students' scientific papers, when writing master's theses, as well as by researchers of the relationship between folklore and literature. The research materials can also be applied in the academic disciplines of folklore studies, literary studies, modern Kazakh literature, literature of the XX century, educational programs "Kazakh language and literature", and "Philology" of

higher educational institutions.

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4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year is provided, indicating the following sections:

1) an analysis of the topics of the peer-reviewed papers;

The dissertation work of N.E. Kartzhan, a doctoral student at Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov, was carried out on the topic "The conceptual sphere of mental activity in fairy-tale discourse (based on Kazakh and English fairy tales)".

The study was conducted jointly with Mukhtarullina Aigul Raisovna, a foreign scientific consultant, Doctor of Philology, Professor at Ufa University of Science and Technology in Ufa. (Ufa, Republic of Bashkortostan, Russian Federation).

The purpose of the study is to identify common and national-cultural features of verbalization and perception in the minds of native Kazakh and English speakers of the conceptual sphere of mental activity through linguistic and conceptual and comparative analysis of fairy-tale discourse.

In the study proposed for protection, the substantial structure of the conceptual sphere of mental activity in fairy-tale discourse was analyzed for the first time based on the material of two differently structured languages. The results of the study demonstrated that mental activity is the most important conceptual system in the consciousness of any nation, conditioned by universal features of human-wide thought processes. The description of the national peculiarities of the manifestation of the parameters of mental activity of the Kazakh and English linguistic cultures in the language was supported by a comprehensive linguistic conceptual and comparative analysis of 306/235 linguistic material collected from fairy-tale texts. As a result, a system of values related to national knowledge, mentality, religion, history, and culture in the worldview of the Kazakh and English peoples was revealed.

In the course of the research, an associative experiment was conducted to identify the semantic specifics of the concept of "mind" and the perception of the conceptual sphere of mental activity in the minds of native speakers of Kazakh and English. As a result of the research, it was found that the associative field of the concept of "mind" and the conceptual sphere of mental activity are widely formed in the minds of speakers, and it is proved that associative connections in the bilingual consciousness completely coincide with lexicographic sources and the content of mental activity in the texts of fairy tales.

2) the relationship of the thesis topic with the directions of science development and (or) state programs formed by the Higher Scientific and Technical Commission under the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan by paragraph 3 of Article 18 of the Law on Science;

The dissertation research work was prepared by the current directions of the development of linguistics – cognitive linguistics (linguconceptology), linguoculturology, discourse study, and the State programs of the Republic of Kazakhstan:

The main results and conclusions of the study were discussed in domestic and foreign research institutions and universities: at the IX International Scientific Conference "Actual Problems of Theoretical and Applied Philology" (Ufa, April 29-30, 2021), at the scientific webinar "The Present and Future of Turkic Philology" (Sterlitamak, November 17, 2021), the reports were reflected in the reports at the scientific seminar for doctoral students "Scientific and Educational Friday" (2022 year) at the Department of Kazakh Philology of the Faculty of Philology of Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov. To identify the specifics of the perception of the conceptual sphere of mental activity in the national linguistic consciousness of native speakers of Kazakh and English, an associative experiment was conducted using the virtual Google platform.

3) analysis of the level of implementation of the results of the theses in practice.

The language material analyzed in the study has great potential for use in the compilation of dictionaries, in addition to textbooks and teaching materials. Recommendations aimed at preventing identified deficiencies in the results of the associative experiment will be important in shaping the level of academic writing, thesaurus knowledge, and skills. The scientific conclusions reached as a result of linguistic and conceptual and comparative analysis of Kazakh and English fairy-tale discourse can be used as a basis for writing graduate, master's, doctoral theses, monographs, and textbooks.
