4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year:

1. Analysis of the topics of the reviewed works:

The dissertation of K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University PhD candidate, **Elmira Temirbayeva Burankulova**, titled "Gender Stereotypes in Turkic Languages." The research was conducted in collaboration with a foreign scientific advisor, PhD **Ömer Faruk Ateş** (Kastamonu University, Turkey). The aim of the research is to scientifically substantiate and practically examine the systemic nature of gender stereotypes in Turkic languages, and to establish the category as a linguistic-cultural phenomenon.

The dissertation of K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University PhD candidate, **Sholpan Gaidarovna Abdirova**, titled "Kazakhstani Ideological Discourse and the Concept of 'Ruhani Zhanguiru'." The research was conducted in collaboration with a foreign scientific advisor, Doctor of Philology, Professor **Gulfiya Rifovna Abdullina** (Ufa Science and Technology University, Republic of Bashkortostan, Russian Federation). The aim of the research is to determine the semantics and linguistic form of the Kazakhstani ideological discourse and to identify the macro-models, lexical-semantic field, associative field, and frame structure of the concept of "Ruhani Zhanguiru."

2. Practical significance of the scientific work:

Elmira Temirbayeva Burankulova's dissertation contributes valuable scientific material to gender linguistics, lexicology and semantics, linguoculturology, sociolinguistics, cognitive linguistics, individual linguistics, and comparative linguistics. The research materials – gender stereotypes, gender-marked phraseological units and proverbs, survey analysis, and data sources

– can be used in thematic projects, course materials, educational-methodological resources, and academic writing.

Sholpan Gaidarovna Abdirova's dissertation has practical significance for the fields of general linguistics, discourse theory, sociology, lexical semantics, linguoculturology, comparative linguistics, and linguistic research methods. The findings can be applied in courses on associative analysis, discourse analysis, and similar subjects.

3. **The relevance of the dissertation topics to the development directions of science and/or government programs:**

The dissertation work aligns with the development direction "7. Social and Humanitarian Research, 7.2. Fundamental, Applied, and Interdisciplinary Research in the Humanities" and government programs approved by the Higher Scientific and Technical Commission under the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, particularly the program "Foundations of the Eternal Nation" (Fundamental and applied research in education and the humanities in the 21st century, 27.04.2016).

4) **Analysis of the level of integration of dissertation results into practical activities:**

The results of Elmira Temirbayeva Burankulova's dissertation were discussed at both domestic and international research institutions and universities, including K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, the Department of Kazakh Philology, Foreign Philology and Translation Studies, and Kazakh Literature (2018-2021). Additionally, scientific articles on the topic were presented at international scientific-practical conferences:

- **Turkey**, Balkesir University's "Dara" Eurasian Innovation Development Center (2019)
- **Uzbekistan**, Tashkent State Institute of Oriental Studies (2019)
- **Bashkortostan**, Russian Academy of Sciences (2019, 2021)
- **Kazakh National Women's Pedagogical University** (2020)

A survey on gender stereotypes and the traditional perception of stability and change in society was conducted via Google Drive across various regions of Kazakhstan (including Aktobe, Almaty, Oral, Nur-Sultan, Kyzylorda, Mangystau, Atyrau) and abroad (Turkey, Bashkortostan, Tatarstan, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan) among respondents aged 15-65.

The main body of the research resulted in the publication of **16 articles**. The key scientific-theoretical results were published in **10 articles** in international scientific-practical conference proceedings in both domestic and foreign conferences. The dissertation research's ideas and conclusions were presented in **3 articles** in periodicals suggested by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan's Committee for Quality Assurance in Education and Science, in the scientific journal **Vatandash** (which is included in the RINC base of the Russian Federation, Republic of Bashkortostan), and in the **International Journal of Society, Culture and Language** (Scopus indexed, Percentile 74%, Q2). Additionally, **1 article** was published in a Scopus indexed textbook titled *Contemporary Kazakh Proverb Research: Digital, Cognitive, Literary, and Ecological Approaches*.

The results of Sholpan Gaidarovna Abdirova's dissertation were presented at scientific seminars, such as:

- K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, the Department of Kazakh Philology (2021)
- M. Akmulla Bashkortostan State Pedagogical University, Department of Philology (2022), titled "*Current Issues in Turkic Philology*"

Associative practical analysis of the concepts "Power" and "Politics" was conducted both traditionally and electronically (via Google Forms) at K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, the "Rukhani Zhangyru" center in Aktobe, as well as at educational and cultural institutions in Aktobe region, such as Kandygash city school gymnasium, Tobyk Zharmaganbetov school in Baiganin district, and in Aktau city.

Traditional format surveys on slogans and appeals were also conducted in schools and cultural institutions in the Baiganin district of Aktobe region.

Dissertation results were presented in **13 publications**, including:

- **5 articles** in publications recommended by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan's Committee for Publishing Scientific Research Results
- **1 article** in the Scopus indexed journal *International Journal of Society Culture & Language* (December 2022, Percentile 74%, Q2)
- **7 articles** in international conference proceedings, including **3 articles** presented at foreign conferences.
