4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, indicating the following sections:

1) an analysis of the topics of reviewed papers;

The dissertation of the doctoral student of the Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov, Kultanbayeva N. K., was presented on the topic «Linguistic and cultural criteria of fairy-tale discourse (based on materials in Kazakh, Russian and Arabic)».

The research work was carried out in collaboration with Mukhtarullina Aigul Raisova, a foreign scientific consultant, Doctor of Philology, professor at Bashkir State University. (Ufa, Bashkortostan, Russia).

The purpose of the research is to identify the linguistic and cultural parameters of the discourse on Kazakh, Russian and Arabic fairy tales, the features characteristic of the genre of fairy tale discourse, and to present a discursive, linguistic and cultural comparative model for analyzing the linguistic and cultural parameters of fairy tale discourse.

The practical significance of scientific work is applicable in general linguistics, general and particular lexicology, theory of discourse, linguistics, comparative linguistics, methods of linguistic research, discourse analysis and

linguistics of the text. It can be used in lexicographic practice and comparative analysis of fairy tale discourse.

3) analysis of the level of involvement of dissertation results in practical activities.

The results of the dissertation work were discussed in domestic and foreign research institutions, universities: Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanova, Department of Kazakh Philology, Russian Philology and Intercultural Communications, Faculty of Philology (2018-2021), Turkey, Mugla Sytki Kochman, Department of Turkish Language, Faculty of Literature (2018-2019), Turkey, Eurasian Center for Innovative Development «Dara», Balikesir University (2019), Bashkir State University, Department of Foreign Language for Humanities, Faculty of Philology (2020), Bashkir State University, Department of Oriental Studies and Bashkir Language, Faculty of Bashkir Philology, Oriental Studies and Journalism (2020), Department of Russian Language and Comparative Philology (2020), Laboratory of Computer Philology (2021). An experimental analysis of the features of oral perception and transformation of fairy-tale discourse was conducted for primary school students of the «Akbobek» school in Aktobe, Secondary school No. 40 of the Shalkar district, secondary school Karatogai, Bayganinsky district, secondary school Zharkamys.

The results of the doctoral dissertation have been published in 9 publications, including 4 in publications submitted by the Committee for Control in the Field of Education and Science of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the publication of scientific research results, 1 article in the scientific database Scopus ASTRA Salvensis (percentile = 85%, Q1. 2021), in collections of international conferences – 4 articles, including at foreign conferences – 2 articles.
