4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, highlighting the following sections:

1) analysis of the topics of the works reviewed;

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of the Zhubanov ARU Zhumasheva K.B. is written on the topic "Gender opposition in language".

Joint research was conducted with a foreign scientific consultant PhD of Pamukkale University, Denizli, Republic of Turkey (Denizli, Republic of Turkey).

The aim of the work is to scientifically substantiate the categorization of gender oppositions in language and prove it from the point of view of associative cognition.

The practical significance of the scientific work is that the scientific concepts and conclusions obtained during the study can be successfully applied in the development and teaching and methodological support of educational courses and programs in social linguistics, cognitive

linguistics, modern linguistics, etymology, lexicology, lingua-mythology, linguacultural studies. The research materials will be valuable for compiling linguistic and cultural reference publications, dictionaries on gender linguistics and other lexicographic works. 2) the connection of the dissertation topic with the areas of scientific development formed by the Higher Scientific and Technical Commission under the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 18 of the Law "On Science" and (or) state programs;

Zhubanov, Department of Theoretical and Applied Linguistics of the Philological Faculty (2020-2023), Department of the Educational Program for the Training of Teachers of Language and Literature of the West Kazakhstan University named after M. Otemisuly (2020-2023), Department of the Turkish Language of the Literary Faculty of Pamukkale University, Turkey (2022). The results of the doctoral dissertation were published in 6 editions, including 3 articles in scientific journals included in the list recommended by the Committee for Quality Assurance in Education and Science of the Ministry of Health and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, 2 articles in the International Journal of Society, Culture and Language, included in the scientific database Scopus (percentile = 83%, Q1, 2022) and the Eurasian Journal of Applied Linguistics (percentile = 85%, Q1, 2022), 1 article in the proceedings of international conferences, including 1 article at foreign conferences.

4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, highlighting the following sections:

1) analysis of the topics of the works reviewed;

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of the Zhubanov ARU Sultangaliyeva O.K. is written on the topic "National character in Kazakh poetry in the post-independence period".

Joint research was conducted with a foreign scientific consultant PhD Kastamonu University, Kastamonu city, Republic of Turkey (Kastamonu, Republic of Turkey).

The purpose of the work is to analyze the concept of "national character" by examining the ideological, artistic, and cognitive aspects of the works of representatives of Kazakh literature of the late twentieth - early twenty-first centuries.

The practical significance of the scientific work is determined by the possibilities of using the materials in conducting courses on literature, national literature, concept, literature of the twentieth century, literature of the independence period, and courses in literary analysis.
