4. The following sections were identified, presenting a brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year:

1) analysis of the topics of the reviewed works;

The dissertation of K. A. Iskakova, a PhD student at K. Zhubanov Aktobe regional state university, was written on the topic «Polydiscursive linguistic personality of Abish Kekilbayev».

The research was conducted in collaboration with foreign academic advisor Professor A. A. Evtugina, Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, Candidate of Philological Sciences, from the Russian State University of Professional Education in Yekaterinburg, Russian Federation.

Purpose of the research to determine the polydiscursive character of Abish Kekilbaev's linguistic personality through analyzing the discursive activity of the writer on the basis of his socio-political activity.

Theoretical and practical significance of the research lies in its ability to expand scientific ideas about polydiscursivity as a characteristic feature of linguistic personality and as a universal category. The results of the research will contribute to the further development of such directions in linguistics as pragmalinguistics, cognitive linguistics, discourse theory, linguopersonology, as well as to the practice of studying, describing and modeling linguistic personality in terms of its discursive realization. The obtained data will help to deepen the understanding and evaluation of the creative heritage of the writer and prominent socio-political figure Abish Kekilbayev, as well as to reveal the specifics of his speech practice in the context of the polydiscursive approach.

4. Brief analysis of dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, indicating the following sections:

1) analysis of the topics of the works reviewed;

The dissertation of Zhazykova R.B., a doctoral student at K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, was completed on the topic “Features of Onomastic Discourse.” Domestic scientific consultant, professor at K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, Doctor of Philology Sadirova Kulzat Kanievnna. The research work was carried out in collaboration with a foreign scientific consultant, Professor of the M. Akmulla Bashkir State Pedagogical University, Doctor of Philology Khusainova Layla Midkhatovna (Ufa, Republic of Bashkortostan, Russian Federation).

The aim of the study is to consider onomastic issues as discursive actions, to study onyms as a process in real life and the result of this process, and to identify the specific features of onomastic discourse.

Practical significance of scientific work. The samples of discursive tools, discursive roles, cultural and social codes, discursive fields, and analysis of onomastic names from the perspective of onomastic discourse and the text of onomastic discourse units conducted in the study are suitable for use in future work in this field. The linguistic material of the study can be used in compiling various dictionaries, writing textbooks and teaching aids, master's and doctoral dissertations.

4. Brief analysis of dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, by the following sections:

#### 1. Analysis of the topics of the reviewed works.

The dissertation of doctoral student B.K. Khassangaliyeva from K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University was carried out on the topic: «Cognitive frame approach in the study of medical terminology (ophthalmology) in the Kazakh and English languages».

The study was conducted jointly with a foreign scientific advisor — Doctor of Philology, Professor Aigul Raissovna Mukhtarullina, University of Science and Technology, Ufa, Republic of Bashkortostan, Russian Federation.

The aim of the research is to propose a model of cognitive-frame analysis of ophthalmology terms in Kazakh and English and to identify the features of professional knowledge verbalization.

The practical significance of the work lies in the fact that the analyzed terms can be used in compiling a Kazakh-English dictionary, explanatory dictionaries, and reference books. The model of cognitive-frame analysis of terms is useful in practical classes on terminology and lexicology. The obtained results are of interest for course papers, theses, master's and doctoral dissertations. The created electronic ophthalmology dictionary can serve as a basis for other dictionaries. A specialized website on ophthalmology terms will become a platform for discussions among professionals, future ophthalmologists, terminologists, and researchers, contributing to the development of Kazakh ophthalmological terminology and the writing of textbooks.

3. Analysis of the level of practical implementation of dissertation results.

The results of the dissertation were discussed in domestic and foreign research institutions and universities: K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, Department of Theoretical and Applied Linguistics, Faculty of Philology (2021–2024); University of Science and Technology, Ufa, Department of Foreign Languages of the Humanities Faculties, Faculty of Philology (2024).

The results of the doctoral dissertation were published in 6 editions, including 2 articles in journals recommended by the Committee for Control in the Field of Education and Science of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan; 2 articles in journals indexed in Scopus: World Journal of English Language (percentile: 47%, Q2, 2025) and Forum for Linguistic Studies (percentile: 55%, Q2, 2025); 2 articles in proceedings of international conferences, including 1 publication at a foreign conference.

4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, indicating the following sections:

- 1) analysis of the topics of the reviewed works;

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of Aktobe K. Zhubanov regional university Mukhan A. was carried out on the topic «Wedding ritual folklore in modern Kazakh society: genre nature, historical evolution, and transformation».

The research work was carried out in collaboration with a foreign scientific consultant, PhD Azap Samet. Associate Professor, Belarusian State University, (Minsk, Belarus).

The purpose of the research is to determine the genre-specific nature of wedding ritual folklore in contemporary Kazakh society, to comprehend its historical evolution, and to analyze the ways in which it has been transformed in modern life.

The results of the dissertation research can be used in the study of various genres of folklore. In addition, the findings of the study may be widely applied in conducting specialized courses and seminar classes in folkloristics for students of higher education institutions. Furthermore, the research results can be offered as a theoretical and practical reference resource for folklorists, university lecturers, undergraduate and graduate students, as well as doctoral candidates.

2) the relationship of the thesis topic with the directions of science development and (or) state programs formed by the Higher Scientific and Technical Commission under the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan in accordance with paragraph 3 of Article 18 of the Law on Science;

The results of the dissertation were presented and discussed at domestic and international research institutions and universities. These included the “Scientific-Cognitive Friday” seminar for doctoral students at the Department of Kazakh Philology, Faculty of Philology, K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University (2021), and the traditional online scientific seminar titled “Topical Issues in Turkic Philology” held at M. Akmulla Bashkir State Pedagogical University (2022). Furthermore, an online survey was conducted via the Google Forms platform (500 respondents) to identify the contemporary transformation and public reception of the *betashar* and *syngsy* genres. Participating institutions included: K. Zhubanov Aktobe Regional University, «Aktobe-Daryn» Regional Scientific-Practical Center for Supplementary Education, Secondary School No. 7 Togys, Aktobe Multidisciplinary Tarlan College, I. Urganisbaev Secondary School, T. Zharmagambetov Secondary School (Baiganin District, Aktobe Region), Aktobe Higher Polytechnic College, Karauilkeldi Secondary School No. 2. Additionally, an electronic survey related to the revitalization and renewal of the *syngsy* genre was disseminated across several regions of Kazakhstan—Atyrau, Kyzylorda, Shymkent, Turkistan, Astana, Almaty, Oral, Kostanay, East Kazakhstan, Zhambyl, Taldykorgan, and Karaganda—garnering responses from 702 participants. The core findings and conclusions of the research were delivered in oral presentations at the following academic conferences: The XIX International Scientific Conference “Youth, Science and Innovation” (Aktobe, April 12, 2023), The Scientific-Practical Conference “Contemporary Problems in Teaching the Bashkir Language in the Republic of Bashkortostan and Other Regions of the Russian Federation” (Ufa, Russia, February 14, 2020), The International Scientific Conference “Kazakh Literary Studies: Tradition and Continuity” (Oral, November 24, 2023). In addition, research related to the dissertation topic was conducted during a research internship at the Institute of History, Language, and Literature of the Ufa Federal Research Center of the Russian Academy of Sciences (Ufa, Russia, February 10 – March 10, 2020).

4. A brief analysis of the dissertations reviewed by the council during the reporting year, indicating the following sections:

1) analysis of the topics of the reviewed works;

The dissertation work of the doctoral student of Aktobe K. Zhubanov regional university Zhetessova Zh. was carried out on the topic «Linguoculturological and cognitive-comparative description of animalistic vocabulary (based on Kazakh and English fairy tales)».

The research work was carried out in collaboration with a foreign scientific consultant, PhD, professor Ekici Metin from the Ege University in Izmir, Turkey (Izmir, Turkey).

The purpose of the study is to identify common and distinctive features of animalistic vocabulary in Kazakh and English fairy tales by means of linguocultural and cognitive – comparative analysis.

In the course of the study, the analyzed language materials and collected data can be used to master animalistic vocabulary, which is found in fairy tales in Kazakh and English, in linguocultural and cognitive aspects, as well as in the development and replenishment of manuals, educational and methodological complexes and special dictionaries. Semantic, symbolic and conceptual features of the names of fairy-tale animals can be effectively used in the formation of linguistic and cultural competence of future specialists, the development of intercultural communication skills and training programs aimed at Translation Studies.
